Guy Manning is something of a perfectionist and always wants to give that something extra and this can be seen in his live shows and he has adopted this approach with the Akoustik concept. We are lucky at the CRS that we have seen him on numerous occasions in acoustic mode but this collection of songs is far more than simple guitar/ keyboard acoustic versions. He has radically re-worked the songs with a variety of musicians along for good measure and this is no mere filler release but a fully stand alone Manning CD that sits proudly alongside the rest of his catalogue.

Sax, flute and clarinet combine beautifully with guitar, mandolin and fiddle giving a surprising folk rock cross over sound to material that is so familiar and yet so different on this disc. Guy is a true treasure and you know that whatever he turns to next will be a fully thought out and committed project from a gentleman of progressive rock. **TC**
